

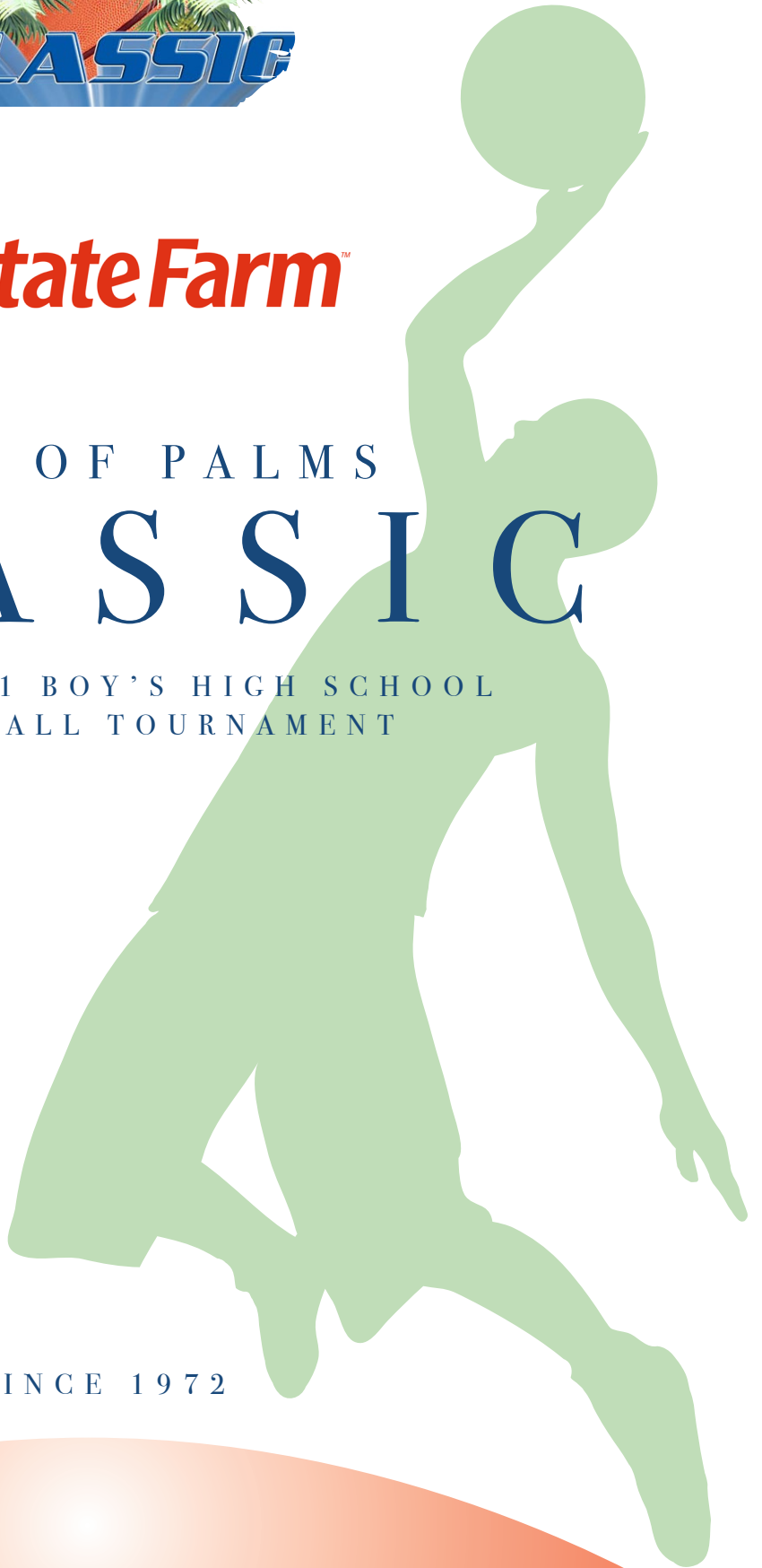

This event, now in its thirty-eighth year, showcases the finest talent among players and teams from all across America bringing players, fans, families, the media, NCAA Division I and II coaches and scouts together for one week of basketball at the highest level.

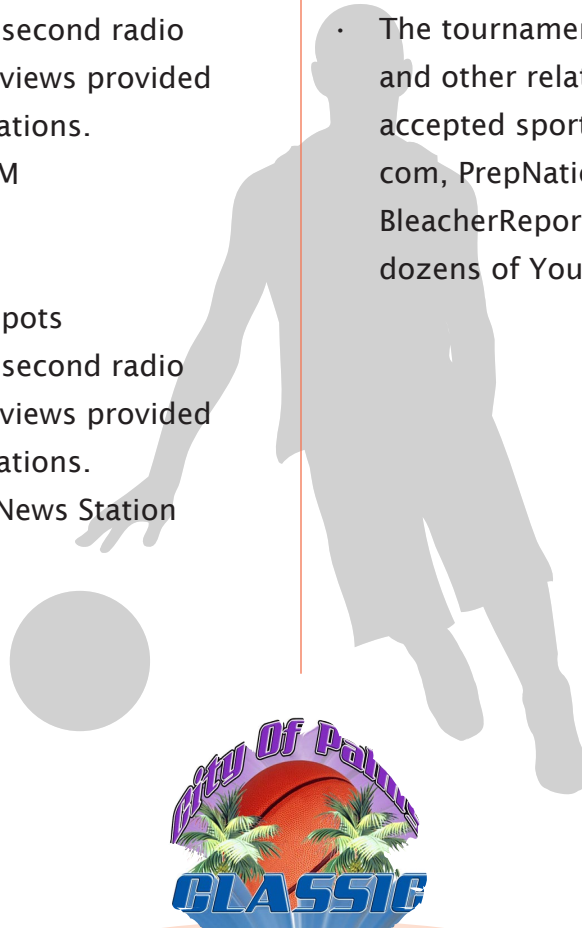

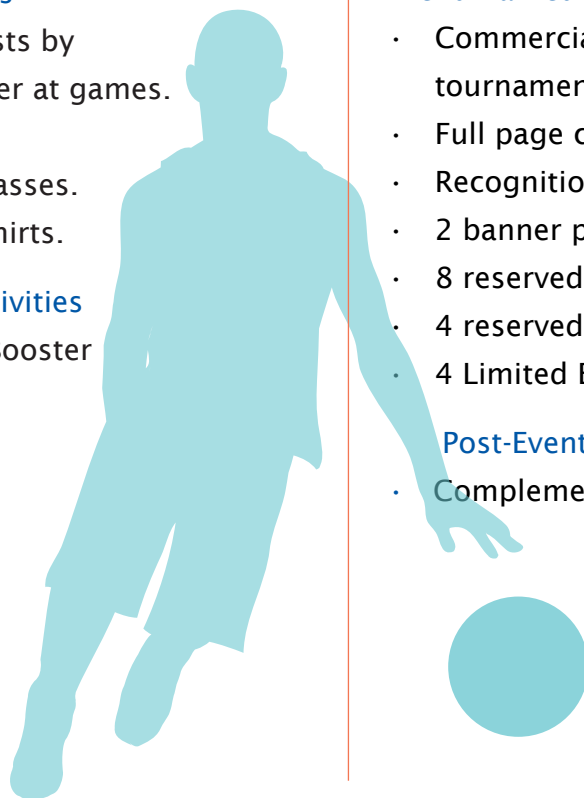

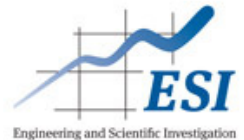
